## Great Meadows Middle School School Health-related Closure Preparedness Plan

## INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN

- Teachers will provide instruction through online textbooks and programs (HMH
  Fusions/Dimensions, Big Ideas Math, IXL Math and ELA, Nearpod), Google Classroom,
  Think Central, video instruction, email, and web-based resources. All teachers at Great
  Meadows Middle School have access to quality online materials and resources and are
  trained in the use of these methods.
- 2. All teachers have access to Google Apps for Education and Google accounts. This allows for tracking of assignments, communication between teacher and student/parents, and time-stamped due dates. Parents will also receive regular updates and alerts through the Realtime Portal Notification System.
- 3. Teachers will ensure all students have access to their Google Classroom and email. Any additional paper based supplies and other items will be sent home with students.

## **EQUITABLE ACCESS TO INSTRUCTION**

- 1. All students received a Chromebook device at the beginning of the year. Families without internet access are provided with a mobile hot-spot for the sole use by the student it is assigned to.
- 2. Any students needing paper-based items will also be given hard-copies of all textbooks and available workbooks to use at home.
- 3. Administrative and support staff will be available at the school to distribute the materials needed for equitable access to instruction.
- 4. In the event a student is unable to access the internet, the student will not be penalized for late/missed assignments and will be afforded reasonable time to make up work, where feasible, either while remote or upon return to school.
- 5. All students will be provided daily lunch meals which can be picked up at Great Meadows Middle School Administrative Offices on Mondays at 3:30 p.m.

## **SPECIAL EDUCATION**

- 1. All IEP and 504 Plan modifications and accommodations will be provided to students through assignments posted on Google Classroom or hard copies.
- 2. Teachers will continue to provide modified coursework, testing, and materials to all students who qualify for those services.
- 3. Students requiring extended time for assignments will be given extended-time based on a school day schedule.
