The Program

For the 2022-23 school year, the GMRSD moved all after school and beyond the school day clubs and activities to our ARP-ESSER grant. The two main benefits to the district are:

- All students are able to participate in these programs, regardless of academic need.
- The Title I funds were used to retain a Title I teacher at Central School. This allows the district to provide support during the school day for students in need of academic interventions.

The Programs

- District Wide
 - SAMS:Students Achieve More in Summer-5 weeks during the summer, academic and social-emotional
 - Homework Club: Academic and study skills multi-subject
- GMMS
 - Saturday Tutoring-: 2-4 Saturdays per month -Focus is Math, ELA and Science
 - HW Club Monday-Thursday 2:30-3:30
- Central
 - Garden Club: Developing social skills, collaboration, and persistence by working around Central School to beautify the campus
